by Giuseppe Verdi

Radames and the pharaoh's daughter Amneris are soon to be wed, but little does anyone suspect that the young warrior is secretly in love with the recently captured Aida. In the end, love and sacrifice shine through the thick fog of war, anger and deceit that rules the world in which they live. The opera *Aida* is considered by many to be the masterwork by a master composer. The score is filled with compelling high romantic music and several top ten operatic tunes.

The elderly Don Pasquale has promised a handsome allowance to his nephew Ernesto if you young man agrees to marry a girl of his uncle's choosing. Ernesto refuses and announces his love for the beautiful Norina. Fortunately for the young couple, the wily Dr. Malatesta is on their side and uses his outlandish schemes and plots to outwit the old man and allow the young couple to find happiness. Donizetti's frolicking opera is considered a masterpiece of bel canto comedy.

The Pearl Fishers (sung in French)

by Georges Bizet

Nadir has been in exile for years, and comes upon his old friend Zurga. The two agree to never to let a woman come between them again. Later that same day Nadir sees Leila, now a temple priestess — the woman that came between he and Zurga. Their passion is soon rekindled which also relights the bitter feud. In the end friendship proves to be stronger than anger and Zurga sacrifices himself so that Nadir and Leila can escape death. While Bizet made his mark in the opera world with *Carmen*, *The Pearl Fishers* is his next most successful work.
