Opera For Everyone Intern Program

Designed for high school students interested in the arts, the Opera For Everyone Intern Program allows participants a hands-on experience working with a professional opera company. Positions vary in the type of time commitment and activity performed but ALL positions require individuals who are very responsible and reliable. Participants in most areas of the program are given assignments that are directly related to the success of a given production and/or performance. A short description of each area follows:

Wigs & Makeup

Must attend several workshops with wig and makeup master Richard Stead. Interns are assigned to work on at least one production and must be available for all dress rehearsals and performances.

Chorus & Supernumerary

Must be available for evening and weekend rehearsals and for all performances of a show. Chorus members must also be available for fall choral rehearsals. (*Chorus Supernumeraries will be on stage during the OFE evening.*)

Office Assistant

Experience working in the HOT offices. Mostly clerical but other experiences as well. Must be available for a set time each week. May also be assigned back stage duties during performances.

Other

Interns have been included in other areas depending upon experience, desire and availability. Please inquire if there is an interest in something that we have not listed.

If students are interested in this opportunity and are very responsible and reliable, please feel free to nominate them. It is best to nominate students soon after receiving this mailing. We often have more students apply than we can accommodate, and the more popular areas are taken very quickly.
