This is HOT's 63rd year of bringing the very best opera performances and education programs to our beautiful island home, and that is only possible with the generous support of people like you who believe in the power of live opera in our community.

Emerging from a pandemic that has lasted over two years, we've created a season that explores the happier side of opera with three productions where no one dies. Don't get me wrong: I love a good cathartic experience in theatre, when I'm reduced to tears as the hero or heroine (or both!) meet their untimely demise over an extended aria or duet. (I mean, what other art form but opera can do that?). But there's an amazing breadth of operas where everyone... well, at least nearly everyone...lives "happily ever after."

We start with an operatic adaptation of one of the most charming children's novels of all times, *The Secret Garden* by Frances Hodgson Burnett. The opera, by composer Nolan Gasser and librettist Carey Harrison, premiered in 2013, a co-commission by San Francisco Opera and Cal Performances in Berkeley. I was working at San Francisco Opera at the time, and I can say that audiences were captivated by this charming telling – and I know you will be too!

We've created a brand-new production, directed by Karen Tiller with media designed by Dave Hunt – the same creative team behind HOT's digital world premiere, *Hometown to the World*, in May 2021, and our recent mainstage production, *The Tragedy of Carmen*. The cast features some exciting company debuts, and you'll see some familiar faces including Taka Komagata, Goro in our April performances of *Madame Butterfly*. I'm extremely proud of the many accomplishments HOT has made during my tenure as your General Director, building on an impressive 60+-year history. Whether this is your first time attending an HOT production or you've been with us since the beginning, mahalo nui loa for believing that opera has a place in our community. You make great art possible!

Synopsis

Mary Lennox is a little girl born in India to British Colonial parents, comfortable and well-to-do. She has everything any child could wish for. Then, out of nowhere, illness strikes. Mary loses her parents to a terrible disease called cholera. She is sent home to England to stay with an uncle she has never met.

1 AND 2-

The uncle, Mr. Craven, lives in a world that is shockingly different to the one little Mary has lived in, with its games and sunlit fun and parties and servants at her command. Craven, the uncle, lives in a gloomy dark old house. He himself is an unhappy person. Like Mary, he has known misfortune: his wife died, and he is still grieving. He takes no interest in Mary, and leaves to go traveling. Alone in the big old house, with a housekeeper and a nursemaid, Mary hears long sad moans in the corridors of the house.

Soon she discovers that the suffering person is her cousin, Craven's son Colin, an unloved boy who believes himself to be a cripple. Mary soon establishes that Colin is perfectly healthy, and she persuades him to join her in the garden she has discovered. This is the garden created by her aunt, whose death doomed the garden to neglect and secrecy - the secret garden! The door had been lost behind ivy, and the key had vanished. A bird - a robin who has noticed the flash of sun on metal helps Mary find the key. As well as the robin, Mary has friends who help her bring Colin back to a happy existence: she has Martha, her merry maid, and Martha's nature-loving brother Dickon, and Ben the gardener. But what will happen when Mr. Craven catches wind from Mrs. Medlock, the housekeeper, who is supposed to be keeping Mary and Colin under control, that they are gallivanting around the secret garden, planting plants and delighting in blossoming trees and bushes that had been lost for years?

Composer's Notes

In the summer of 2009, I performed a solo piano concert that included several original works; in the audience, happily, was David Gockley — then General Director of the San Francisco Opera. Mr. Gockley and I began a conversation that culminated in the commission of a "family opera" for SF Opera's 2012-2013 season.

Although I was well versed in a wide array of compositional approaches, this was my first opera, and thus an opportunity I found both thrilling and daunting. For my collaborator, I turned to my good friend and brilliant playwright, Carey Harrison, and the two of us began a furious search for the perfect source upon which to base our family opera — one, as Mr. Gockley put it, to be both "timeless and operatic." After much deliberation, we settled on Francis Hodgson Burnett's 1911 classic, *The Secret Garden* — a deep and meditative story ideal for the entire family while allowing a more accurate adaptation than the 1991 musical.

Given the practical constraints of the forthcoming performance, I was asked to limit the forces to eight singers and ten instrumentalists; for the latter, I settled on a wide representation of orchestral forces: four strings, two winds, two brass, piano, and percussion — which indeed enable a rich and eclectic variety of sounds and effects.

Stylistically, I was intent on writing a work that struck a balance between tuneful and accessible on the one hand and serious and operatic on the other — especially given then, at times, dramatic and emotionally dense moments that Hodgson-Burnett's story yields. The opera thus includes relatively simple, lyrical numbers such as "I Found the Secret Garden," "My Crooked Shape," "When I Was India," "That Bird," and "I'll Make a Man Yet"; as well as darker, more complex moments, such as Mary's first encounter with Colin early in Act 2 — and everything in between. It was an additional treat to compose, in the Prologue, music with Indian elements — a musical language I have long studied and incorporated into multiple works.

This is the third performance of *The Secret Garden*, and I am extremely grateful to Andrew Morgan, Maestro Elizabeth Askren, Karen Tiller, our wonderful cast and orchestra, and the entire Hawai'i Opera Theatre team for enabling this exciting new production —for which Carey and I took the opportunity to make a few impactful modifications ("writing is re-writing"). Enjoy and mahalo!

The final offering for the mainstage season is Puccini's only comic opera, Gianni Schicchi. This hilarious farce is filled with ridiculous plans, hijinks, and trickery. It is the perfect opera for first-timers and includes one of opera's most famous arias, "O mio babbino caro."

We welcome you to experience opera in a different light... a brighter light. So sit back and enjoy the season of sunshine.


ORVIS YOUNG VOICES
